Registration and Training Policy

- S.O.R.D. International, LLC is a highly diverse company that is committed to serving the law enforcement and military special operations community throughout the world. With this commitment in mind, S.O.R.D. International employs instructors that not only have extensive law enforcement and/or military special operations experience in their respective fields, but who have the unique ability to pass in their experience and knowledge to others through hands-on state of the art realistic training.

Tactical Training Eligibility

All tactical and weapons training courses are restricted to active law enforcement officers, reserve law enforcement officers, military personnel, emergency medical personnel assigned to a tactical team and security personnel tasked with a tactical mission. All students must provide proper agency documentation at the time of course registration.

Most of the courses that S.O.R.D. International offers will require the students to perform a wide range of common physical activities associated with tactical operations. All students should be in adequate physical condition.

Civilian Training and Xtreme Ops Eligibility

Each student who wishes to attend a S.O.R.D. International training course must submit to a criminal history background screening. Those students who possess a valid concealed weapons permit from one of the 50 states which was issued within one year of the course commencement date may waive the background screening. Further, students who are members of the armed forces, law enforcement, private security and school teachers may also waive the background screening. S.O.R.D. International reserves the right to require a background screening on any potential students or refuse training to anyone who does not wish to submit to a background screening. The criminal history background screening is a non-refundable \$25.00 fee. Background screenings are valid for a period of one (1) year.

Student Attire

Students must be in a agency approved training uniform for law enforcement courses. Military personnel should wear the uniform of the day as authorized by their command.

Equipment

When attending any of our courses, students are recommended to bring any individual or team tactical gear that would normally be used in a tactical operation. Students are required to wear body armor, wrap around eye and ear protection at all times while conducting live fire exercises. Students are also responsible for providing their own weapon systems.

Ammunition

Ammunition **is not** included in the course tuition. Students are responsible for providing their own ammunition for training. However, if you wish to purchase ammunition from S.O.R.D. Intl., please specify the caliber and quantity at the time of registration or contact us at least 30 days prior to the course convening date.

Tuition Payment

All payments must be received by the class commencement date. Agencies/Student(s) will receive a full refund of course tuition if cancelled in writing 30+ days prior to the course commencement date. Agencies/Student(s) will receive any paid course tuition minus 25% if cancelled in writing less than 30 days prior to the course commencement date. If a student(s) is a no show, S.O.R.D. will not refund the course tuition. Qualified substitutions are always acceptable.
